- Other formats should reflect an equivalent investment of effort; the committee will apply these criteria flexibly in the interests of including the largest possible number and variety of submissions.
- Papers should include the title only. Leave out your name, subject number, subject title, and image (if submitting a visual project) as they will be anonymously evaluated by the prize committee.
